- **Leave Request**, enables students to submit leave applications online with a two-level approval system and passcode-based check-in/check-out for

in-house campus attendance tracking.

- **Course & Hostel Feedback**, allows students to provide mandatory feedback before leaving the campus.
- **Apply NOC**, facilitates students to apply for a No Objection Certificate (NOC) with a 5-level approval

system with generation of a check-out code to confirm their exit from campus.

- **Resume Upload**, provides facility to store resume of all students to assist in their future placement opportunities.


