requiring assistance and with coordination local emergency services as per protocol was demonstrated during the mock drill. Fire station in-charge briefed all security personnel regarding various rescue procedures and provided hands-on training to students regarding use of fire extinguishers and familiarization with fire safety equipment.



Tips for Great Body Language -


- 1. **Smile**
